Council Remuneration Bylaw

BYLAW NO. 01-2018

A bylaw to provide for remuneration to members of council.

The Council of the Corporation of the Northern Village of Pinehouse, in an open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as "Council Remuneration Bylaw No. 01-2018"
2. The mayor shall be paid an annual remuneration in the following amount in the year indicated: up to and including \$150,000 for 2018.
3. Each councillor shall be paid a remuneration for attending meetings as indicated in the **policy and procedure manual**:

2.00 COUNCIL REMUNERATION

2.02.01 Regular and Special Meetings

\$100.00 for each Councillor that attends a regular or special meeting of Council.

These figures are based on a 3 hour meeting with the amounts being prorated to the nearest half hour.

2.02.02 Out of Town Meetings

Council approval is required to attend any out of town meetings if any remuneration will be claimed.

Traveling time will also be considered and can be claimed at a rate of \$20.00 per hour to a maximum of \$200.00 per day including remuneration. \$100.00 will be allowed for travel days if traveling the day before or after the meeting date.

2.02.03 Committees and Portfolio

A written report on all committee meetings attended and portfolio work done along with the number of hours being claimed at \$15.00 per hour to a max of \$100, must be presented to Council at a regular or special meeting before any payments will be made.


5. One third of the remuneration established by this bylaw shall be deemed to be an allowance for expenses incidental to the discharge of duties of the office.
6. A special committee will meet to discuss this bylaw and recommend rates for council.
7. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect when read for a third time.


